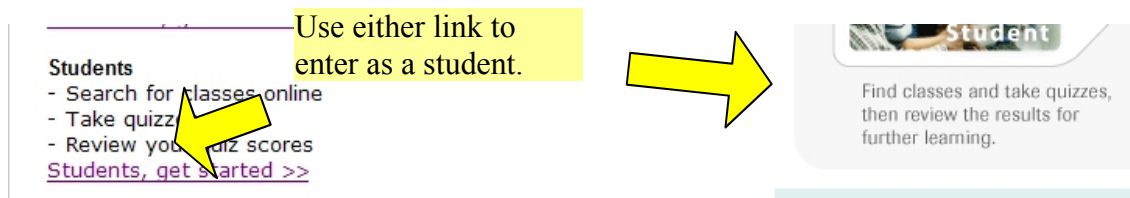

### III. Registering for a Class

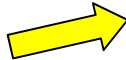

### Classes

Your instructor will need to remove you from the class if you are to take its quizzes no longer.

Use the blue section to search for a class. You can search for up to four classes at a time by teacher's name, keyword, or class title.

Use the green section to search for a particular quiz. You can search for two quizzes at a time by wither teacher name or quiz title.

Select your search using the pull down menu. Type the name, keyword, or title in the empty text field, empty box. Select "search."

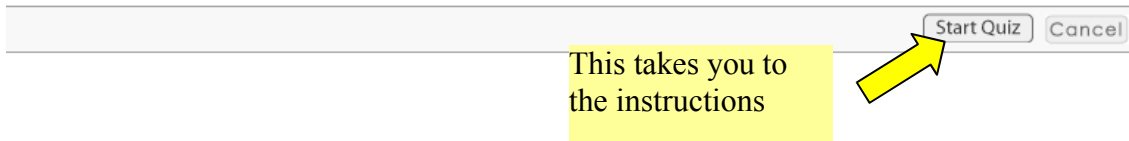

## V. Viewing your results

At the end of a quiz you will see this bar.

This bar appears at the end of the test. It will take you to a summary.

Select "next page" to go to a summary page.



You will be able to review all of your answers at the end of the quiz.

It will also let you go to the question and change your answer.

## VI. Help

If you need help at any time select the "help" button.

This provides you with definitions for each of the icons and directions.

**Take Quiz** Locate the quiz title you wish to complete, then follow the row across to the right and click the button to begin the quiz.

**Review Quiz** Review your performance from most recent attempt, quizzes are able to be reviewed inbetween attempts, at the completion of your total allotted attempts, when the class has expired the quiz or when the time for taking the quiz has expired.

**Unable to Review Quiz** The quiz is either unable to be reviewed inbetween individual attempts or the entire class has not expired the quiz. Finish the number of attempts you have, or after the class to finishes you will be able to review the quiz.

**Complete Quiz** The time to take the quiz is over. You have either expired the maximum number of

**Directions**

The two main functions of this page are to display quizzes from this class that are available to **Take** and then also **Review**.

- 1. To take a quiz**, find the quiz title then follow the row across to the right until you locate a button that says Take that looks like this . With your mouse click on that button. This will direct you to the page where you receive directions about the particular quiz you about to take. If this is not the quiz you wish to take you have the ability to Cancel with out affecting the performance of that quiz.
- 2. After you have expired the quiz attempt** you may have the ability to take the quiz again, depending upon the number of attempts your instructor has given. The number of attempts are displayed next to the quiz title in parenthesis.
- 3. To review the quiz**, simply click on the Review Quiz button inline with the quiz title that looks like this . If for some reason you are not able to review this quiz, there will be an icon that looks like this
